- To participate in the clinical supervision of practicum students.
- To participate on community committees and boards to develop and maintain relevant community services.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A Master's degree in Social Work or Psychology, or the equivalent in work experience, training and education. (To qualify as having the equivalent to a Master's degree, a person must have a Bachelor's degree, such as a B.S.W. or B.A. (Hon. Psych) that includes several courses in counselling theory and practice and a counselling practicum, plus additional training and at least six years' experience as a psychotherapist).
- Eligible for registration in a professional association and eligible for liability insurance to practice psychotherapy.
- Three years' experience as an individual, couples and family therapist.
- Experience in program and group leadership.
- Significant clinical training in a broad range of assessment and treatment skills, for individual, couple and family therapy.
- Demonstrated ability to work as an independent practitioner within a multi-disciplinary health care team.
- Compatible with the philosophy of the CHSA.
- Must be bondable.
